Napoleon Area City School District Announces Opening Dates and Bus Information

The 2018-19 classes of the Napoleon Area City School District will begin at **both buildings** on Thursday, August 23rd. The starting and dismissal times of each school are as follows: Napoleon Jr./Sr. High School, 8:10 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Napoleon Elementary School, Grades 3 – 6, 8:12 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Napoleon Elementary School – Grades PK – 2nd, 8:20 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Classes will be held for a full day and cafeterias will be open.

Lunch prices for Type A will be: Grades PK-6, \$2.90; Grades 7-12, \$2.95 and Chef salad will be \$3.60. Breakfast will also be available for students in grades PK-12 at a cost of \$1.55. Student milk prices will be .55. ***All student meals include milk and this year includes the following in grades 7-12:

6" Subway student type A meal: \$4.25

6" Subway adult type A meal: \$4.25

Napoleon Junior & Senior High School students will attend classes on opening day, Thursday, August 23rd with regular starting and dismissal times of 8:10 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. All high school students shall report to class as defined by his or her academic schedule for a normal instructional day.

Parents with children new to the Napoleon Area School District are urged to register their children as soon as possible, but **prior to** August 15th between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. at the Jr. /Sr. High office for students in grades 7-12 and Napoleon Elementary office for students in grades PK-6. If bus service is needed, contact the Transportation Department at 419-592-2403 or toll free at 1-888-592-2403.

Fall kindergarten screening for students attending the public schools will be held on Thursday, August 23rd at 8:30 a.m. at Napoleon Elementary School, 725 Westmoreland Avenue. (This is a makeup session for students that did **not** attend the screening held in April or students new to the District.)

All kindergarten and beginndergarten students will attend Napoleon Elementary School (per letter received). Kindergarten Readiness Assessment times and classes will be held according to their letter received. All assessments and orientations will be held at Napoleon Elementary School for kindergarten.

Classes will be held on an all-day basis beginning **Thursday, August 23rd for 1st – 6th grade students, and Tuesday, August 28th for beginndergarten and kindergarten students. Preschool classes will begin Friday, August 24th**. The starting and dismissal times are as follows: Grades PK – 2nd, 8:20 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.; Grades 3 – 6, 8:12 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Four County Career Center classes for Juniors and Seniors and any new students will begin on **Wednesday, August 15th**. Transportation is provided from the High School leaving at 8:05 a.m. and returning to the High School at 3:15 p.m.

Classes at Independence Education Center will begin on **Wednesday, August 15th**; Call the Transportation Office for Bus Stop Locations and times.

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Bus Routes have been revised but most School bus routes will be about the same as last year. Post cards will be sent out soon to students entering kindergarten and to families that have a bus change from last year. The first bus pickups will begin at approximately 6:40 a.m. Students should watch for the buses the first few days until the routes are established. Emergency Training for ALL buses will be August 23rd and 24th in the afternoon. Buses will deliver students home later than the normal scheduled time.

Pupils residing in the village of Florida will have the opportunity to get on the bus at one of the following pickup points:

All Florida pupils should be at the pickup points by 7:15 a.m.

- 1) **Bus #25**– corners of E High St & Chester Street, E High St & Henry St., corner of Church and N Vine St, and W High St & N. Canal St.
- 2) **Bus # 7** will pick-up on the corners of School St & Michaels Dr.

Pupils residing in the Village of McClure will have the opportunity to get on the bus at one of the following pickup points:

All McClure pupils should be at the pickup points by 7:10 a.m.

- 1) **Bus #4** – corner of Depot/Union Streets, Union & Reed, Carl/Union, and Carl/ Frank.
- 2) **Bus #6** – corners of Rt. 65 & Henry Street/Haley and Summit Streets.
- 3) **Bus #8** – corners of Hockman Street/ SR 65, South Haley Street/ SR 65, Beaver/ Henry Streets, and Cross/West Streets.

- Bus #20 720 Stout St – 7:25 a.m.
- Bus #20 Hawks Pizza Parking Area – 7:25 a.m.
- Bus #11 Anthony Wayne Acres - 7:20 a.m.
- Bus #11 Riviera Heights – 7:30 a.m.
- Bus #11 Twin Oaks – 7:25 a.m.
