Below is a list of supplies you will need for the Napoleon Jr. High School Seventh Grade. A few more items may be added to the list once school begins, but this will get you off to a good start.

General Items

- pens (blue, black, red)
- multiple pencils (regular or mechanical)
- loose leaf college ruled notebook paper for all classes (2 packs)
- scissors
- a ruler

- dry erase marker
- 12 count colored pencils
- 8 count crayons
- Elmer's liquid School Glue
- blue, yellow, and pink highlighter
- pink eraser

Homebase

- two boxes of tissues
- 12 pack of pencils

Math

- spiral notebook about 100 pages
- folder or binder (Buchhop's class)
- calculator model:
 - Texas Instrument 30 XIIS (which can be used into high school)

- 2 inch binder with 4 tab dividers
- 1 small pack index cards with lines

- 1 composition notebook

Below is a list of supplies you will need for the Napoleon Jr. High School Eighth Grade. A few more items may be added to the list once school begins, but this will get you off to a good start. Refill as necessary.

General Items

- three highlighters (any color)

- one box of colored pencils
- two boxes of tissues

- large pink eraser
